Princess Ann County February 15 day 1733/4 In the Name of God Amone
James Cumberfoot being very sick & weak of body but of perfect & disposing
mind & memory praised be God for it do make & ordaine & appoint this my last
will & Testament manner & form following viz: I give & bequeath my
Soul into the hands of almighty God hoping to be saved through the merits of
Iesus Christ my Eve blessing & commending my body to the earth to be decently
buried at the discretion of my Executor hereafter named: - I'm that all my
depts & funerall charges be contented & paid: - I'm: I give & bequeath to my well
belov'd son John Cumberfoot all my Tract & plantation of land whereon
now live containing one hundred acres to him & his heirs for ever not misus-
ing his mother during her widowhood: - and as for the rest of my Estate
both personal & real I give & bequeath to be equally divided amongst my wife
and children & my will is that my wife shall have the use of all my Estate during
her widowhood & after I desire my friend John Bonney may have an oversight
of my children if he find they are misfod also appointing my loving wife
Margret Cumberfoot my sole & sole Executor of this my last will & Testament
revoking & disanuling all other wills & Testaments by me formerly made
