 de. If son Peter called pig point for Peter Gauge & y^e north on part for James & their heirs for
 ever but if James Gauge doth not come within six years from y^e date of this point or deal then his

Land & stock belonging to me to be divided betwixt Rich^d Dauge & Peter Dauge paying yearly to their mother a barrel of good beef to be delivered at John Bonney landing: - as for y^e rest of my movables my desire is that they may be valued & after my wife's decease to be divided among all my children but nothing to be forced from her during her widowhood appointing my said beloved wife to be whole and sole execut^r of this my said will & ordering her brother M^r. Bonney to be an assistant to her that she make no bargains without his consent & for y^e validity whereof I have affixed my hand & seal this 15th day of April 1719: - (y^e word of widowhood interlined before y^e signing & sealing ~)

In the Name of God Amen y^e 8th day of May in the year of our Lord God 1719: I Robert Bray in y^e Count^y of prince's Anne being sick & weak in body but of perfect mind & memory thanks be given to god therofore calling unto mind y^e mortality of my body & knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die do make & ordain this my last will & Testament that is to say principally & first of all I give & recommend my soule into y^e hands of god that gave it & for my body I recommend it to y^e earth to be buried in a Christianlike & decent manner at y^e discretion of my Ex^{or}: hereafter named nothing doubting to receive y^e same at y^e generall resurrection by y^e mighty power of god as touching such worldly estate wherewith it hath pleased god to lend me I give devise & dispose of y^e same in y^e following manner & forms: my Just debts being paid I give y^e same as followeth. I give & bequeath to my loving wife my riding horse & one negro man called goo: & one negro girl called mole during her life & after her decease my negro fellow goo: to my son Plomer & his heirs and likewise my negro girl called mole to my daughter Mary Bray to her & her heirs forever & her increase my negro girl mole to be delivered to my daughter Mary when she comes of age or marries & likewise my negro: goo: to my son Plomer when he comes to age after my wife's decease. I give & bequeath to my loving wife Iacomen Bray eighty eight acres of land springing with
