Princess Anne County Virginia Wills 1724-1735

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In the Name of God Amen I James Haynes of prince ann County being very Sick & weak of body but of sound & perfect memory & Caling to mind the uncertainty of this mortal life do make & ordain this my last will in manner & form following over & above all Testaments by me heretofore made: I give & bequeath my soul into the hands of Jesus Christ my Saviour & Redeemer, whom I trust to hope to have full pardon & remission for all my past sins & offences of my body I give to the earth from whence it came to be buried in such decent manner as my Exors hereafter named shall think fit & convenient & for all such worldly goods as it hath pleased God out of his great goodness to bestow upon me I give in manner & form following: I give & bequeath unto my son John Haynes my silver Tankard & my feather bed I give upon all the furniture belonging thereto: one Dark Cullered mare aboute two years old & one ewe lamb marked of his own mark & all hogg mark of his own mark one frame plate & all my wearing cloathes & cloath that I have to make up to him & his heirs for ever. I give & bequeath to my daughter Frances Haynes one large stool skin trunk with locks & keys one large looking glass & frame & all the bath of her mark given her by Capt. Henry Moore & all her mothers wearing cloathes & two gold rings & one silver spoons one gold bracelet & one pair silver shoe clasps & little versiched box & one silver tooth picke to her & her heirs for ever: I give my will is all my land that I had of Sary f man shall be sold by my Executors after named as they shall think fit and all my debts to be paid out of it & what is left of said sale of my land to be equally divided betwixt my two said children John & Frances Haynes to them & their heirs for ever. I give & bequeath unto my sons The said John & Frances Haynes & my daughter Margaret Brust one shilling the said shilling to be paid out of my Estate by my Exors whom I shall hereafter name to them and their heirs for ever: I give & bequeath unto my daughter Frances Haynes my next best feather bed with bolster & all the furniture belonging to it & my best ring mare called Star to her & her heirs for ever: I give my will is that all the rest of my Estate both personal & real that I shall or may in England or Elsewhere fall to me by any will or Testaments of my relations & all the rest of my Estate which I have not already given to be equally divided betwixt my two children John & Frances Haynes to them & their heirs for ever: but if either of these my formentioned two children John & Frances Haynes should die before they marry or come to the age of twenty one then my will is that the other child should enjoy & possess the whole that is given them by my said will & further my will is that my son John Haynes immediately after my said will is proved shall have immediate possession of his part of my Estate before given: & my daughter Frances Haynes to be possessed with her share immediately after 4 day of marriage or at the age of twenty one years and further my will is that these my children John & Frances Haynes should live & abide with their brother Henry to each house during their minority: & whom I do ordain & appoint with my son John Haynes to be legs of this my last will & Testament I write & witness whereunto I have set my hand & fixed my seal this 13. day of Aug. 1724

& his heirs for ever. — I Item I give & bequeath to my daughter Frances Haynes one large stool
skin trunk with locks & keys one large looking glass & frame & all the cattle of her mark
given her by Capt. Henry Mass & all her mothers wearing cloathes & two gold rings & one silver
spoons one gold basket & one pair silver shoe clasp & little vernished box & one silver tooth pick
to her & her heirs for ever. I Item my will is all my land that I had of Savy f^r man shall be sold
by my Executors after named as they shall think fit and all my debts to be paid out of it &
what is left of y^e said sale of my land to be equally divided between my two said two children
John & Frances Haynes to them & their heirs for ever. — I Item I give & bequeath unto my sons The
James & Thomas Haynes & my daughter Margret Bunt one shilling Sta^r money to each of
them to be paid out of my Estate by my Ex^rs whom I shall hereafter name to them and their
heirs for ever. — I Item I give & bequeath unto my daughter Frances Haynes my next best
feather bed with bolster & all the furniture belonging to it & my riding mare called flos to her & her
heirs for ever. — I Item my will is that all the rest of my Estate both personal & real that I shall
or may in England or elsewhere fall to me by any wills or Testaments of my relations & all
the rest of my Estate which I have not already given to be equally divided between my
forermentioned two children John & Frances Haynes to them & their heirs for ever: but if
either of these my forermentioned two children John & Frances Haynes should die before
they marry or come to the age of twenty one then my will is that the other survivor shall enjoy
the whole that is given them by my said will & further my will is that my son John Haynes
immediately after my said will is proved shall have immediate possession of his part of my Estate
before given: & my daughter Frances Haynes to be possessed with her share immediately after 4th
day of marriage or at the age of twenty one years and further my will is that these my children
John & Frances Haynes should live & abide with their brother Henry Woodhouse during their
minority: — whom I do ordain & appoint with my son John Haynes to be Ex^rs of this my last
will & Testament I in witness whereunto I have set my hand & fixed my seal this 13th day of Aug^r 1722
