In the Name of God Amen: I James Moore of the County of Princeps Anne in the
Colony of Virginia being in perfect Health or better of sound mind & perfect memory &
I give & bequeath unto my beloved daughter Anne Talow one negro man named
Jack one negro girl named Phillis one negro wench called James together with her
two children called Mary & Lucy & one half of my long house at Norfolk next
to John Wallaces & all the vacant land joining therewith after my just debts
are paid to her & her heirs forever I give & bequeath unto my beloved son
James Moore all the plantation past I bought of Francis Spratt being the land
whereon I now live as also one hundred acres of land to be taken out of the
part of that land of formerly Thoroughgood Spratts this said one hundred acres
to adjoin on the division line formerly made between or held between the
said Francis Spratt & Thoroughgood his brother lying in Princeps Anne
County with the appurtenances together with the following Slaves
viz. Young Tom Indian one negro boy called Little Tom negro Joe
a fellow an old fellow called Mingo one girl Phillis one wench called
to him & his heirs forever I give & bequeath unto my beloved son
Moore the other half of my long house in Norfolk together with one
shop & all the vacant land belonging thereto together with one negro
boy named Little Will one negro fellow named Harry one negro wench named
Mary her child old Indian Tom & all the land as a residue of formerly
Thoroughgood Spratts land this said residue being two hundred acres not
before given & is part of three hundred acres purchased from said
Thoroughgood Spratt formerly after my just debts are paid the same I
give to him & his heirs for ever. it is my desire my son John should
take possession of the house & shop & hisin before given after my debts
are paid, as also one bed & furniture to him & his heirs forever. I have
& bequeath unto my son James Moore further all the vacant land from
aforesaid shop except Twenty foot adjoining to the said house wherein
I lately lived at Norfolk & fronting the street & running back as the bound-
ary is to the back line likewise all the Furniture viz. Tables, Glasses, Bras-
dish & standing in my Hall together with the bed wherein I now
commonly sleep as also my Stallion Dolphin all my military Acco-
traments to him & his heirs for ever. I have & bequeath unto my be-
loved son Francis Moore my dwelling house at Norfolk where
I lately lived & Twenty foot of land adjoining the said house as also all
that land I bought of William Cartwright in Princeps Anne County
together with one negro boy named Jack one fellow called Nander one
Negro wench called Jimmy together with her two children Venus and
George one girl called all one negro fellow called Lewis one bed & furniture
to him & his heirs forever. And further it is my desire that all my

Estate be Invented after my decease which is not already given away & that the same may be returned to Court, & likewise my desire & expectation is that my very good Friend William Nimsone will take upon him to be Executor in conjunction with my son James Moore whom I also appoint as an Executor with my last will & Testament with full power & Authority to sell & dispose of all my Land and manors at Hannys Creek where I am now proposed lying & being in Princeps Anne County & likewise that my said Executors may have full power to mortgage all my Lands in Norfolk upon good Security towards discharging my just debts it is likewise my desire that my said Executors or Executors above mentioned may not give Security in proving this my said will & further it is my desire that all the Timber that is on Edw Heres Land being at many anes formerly made of his the said Heres Land now in possession of said Heres but reserving the Timber to my self as by deeds may more fully appear lying & being on Tanner's Creek likewise be applied to the best use for the discharge of my last full debts my desire is likewise that to the Common Computations of 5000 Acres of Corn hills lying at or near Adam Lovetts where I am now clearing ground the said quantity may be cleared to consist of 5000 Acres & the Timber arising therefrom be sold & converted to the best use likewise for the discharge of my last full debts. Further my desire is that the following negroes be hired but for the discharge & payment of my just debts, untill then my said debts be lawfully & justly paid the said negroes to be hired out at the discretion of my Executors herebefore mentioned, Viz One Indian Tom, negro Tom, negro Xander negro Lewis negro Harry negro Will, now if in case that if the aforesaid mortgages, Rents, & hireage, of the aforesaid negroes with what other profits may accrue in Rearing of the aforesaid ~~negroes~~ from my lands at the discretion or produce of my Executors may amount to so much as may pay my last full debts, then the former devise of mine (that James Moore be sold for the discharge of my last full debts) be null & void, & that the same Lands of Hannys Creek be equally divided between my three Children James, John, & Francis to them & their heirs forever Separately, all the rest of my household goods consisting of Furniture not before given my desire is may be equally divided between my two sons John & Francis to them & their heirs forever. My desire is that my stock of all or any kind whatsoever not before given be equally divided between my four Children Anne Talum James Moore John Moore & Edw Moore to them & their heirs forever.
