soul into the hand of almighty God my Creator hoping & trusting in the above ment-  
ioned Jesus Christ my Redemer for full & free pardoning all my sins in my body & soul  
will to be buried in a decent manner by me & my heirs after named not doubting but  
shall receive same again by the mighty power of God for my worldly goods  
I give & bequeath as followeth: Item I give & bequeath unto my loving wife Eliz  
Tonent my first negro with their increase being by name Lazar, Tom, Jack, Mr.  
Sarah a negre woman to her & her heirs for ever, also David & two more to chil-  
dren during their servitude limited by act of assembly I give unto said wife her  
for ever. Item I give & bequeath unto my daughter Elizabeth Tonent four  
negroes & their increase being by name Alice a negro woman & her two children,  
Belly & Sarah also a bsd negro & Peggy etc to her my said Daughter & her heirs for ever  
but if in case she should Die before she comes to the age of twenty one years to  
those four negroes & all their increase to Ioseph & equally between her two brothers  
James & Samuel Tonent & to their heirs: Item I give & bequeath unto my eldest  
son James Tonent Two hundred pounds which I have in the hands of Capt. John Hico  
merchant in London to be possed with y<sup>e</sup> same when he comes to of age of Twenty one  
also I give unto my son Samuel Tonent one hundred pounds in y<sup>e</sup> hands of Capt. John  
Hico when he comes to of age of Twenty one years: further my will is that the  
three hundred pounds which I have given to my two sons James & Samuel in y<sup>e</sup> hands of  
Capt. John Hico be put out to Interest to the best advantage till my aforesaid children  
come to age & the Interest of y<sup>e</sup> said money to go to my wife toward bringing up & edu-  
cating my two sons: Item I give & bequeath unto my loving wife Eliz: Tonent  
my daughter Elizabeth all my household goods to be equally Divided between them in  
wife having the liberty of disposing of such things as are perishable to their best  
advantage, also I give unto my said wife one Trunk of L<sup>t</sup> goods to her proper  
use: Item I give unto my two Sons James & Samuel for  
which I have in this County & sixteen hundred which I ha-
