given to almighty God: & being sensible of the certainty of Death though I know thereof is most uncer-
tain and being desirous to settle that small Temporal Estate which it hath pleased God to lend me: do
therefore make this my last will & Testament in manner & form following: & first & principally I
bequeath my soul to almighty God my heavenly father Trusting & hoping that in & through y^e blessed
Death & passion of my only Saviour Jesus Christ to receive free pardon & remission of my sins and
offences: & my body to y^e earth from whence it came to be decently buried at y^e Discretion of my
Executor hereafter named and I give and bequeath unto William Donney Son of Katherine
Donney my whole Estate that I am now possessed withall: at y^e Day of my Death to him his heirs-
lawfully begotten of his body: to be possessed withall when he comes to y^e age of one & Twenty years
or at y^e day of marriage only my desire is That Thomas Dravaghan have a Cow at my death
Item my desire is that if William Donney lives to possess this my Estate & should prove unkind to y^e
negro befr: & good proof made of y^e same that thou y^e said negro befr to be set free
Item my desire is that all my lawfull Debts be first paid: and I do nominate my friend Thomas withard
my whole & sole Executor of this my last will & Testament: In witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand & affixed my Seal this first Day of October anno Domini 1716
