Capps's Will

In the Name of God Amen I John Capps of the Parish of
Synhacen and County of Princeps Ann being very sick and weak & I am I
give and bequeath unto my son James Capps the Land that belonged to Edward
Cannon up to the river or Low Dyke that divides the said Land from the Plan-
tation whereon I now live to him and his heirs for ever and also one Cow &
Calf & a two year old Heifer also one Ewe & Lamb & Two loads of three pigs I also
one feather Bed and the furniture & accounts belonging I do give and be-
queath unto my son Henry Capps the Land that was Dennis Cannon's
up to a river that Leads from the Woods to the Marsh of said Run divides the
Plantation whereon I now live from that plantation whereon Thos Good Capps
now lieth to him and his heirs for ever also one Cow and calf and year old
one Ewe and Lamb one sow and her piggs and one Bed and the furniture
pertaining belonging I do give and bequeath unto my son John Capps all
the Remainder of my high Land to him and his heirs for ever. I do
give unto my three Boys above Named all my Marsh Land to be equally
divided between them and their heirs for ever I do give and bequeath unto my
Daughter Mary Capps two young Cows and two Calves and a two year old he-
ifer. I do give and bequeath unto my Daughter Margaret Capps One Cow &
Calf & a Heifer I do give & bequeath unto my four Children Namely John
Solomon Charles & Amy Capps all the Remainder of my Estate of all Kinds
and Nature Whatsoever to be equally Divided between them only my Dear
is that my well beloved Wife Dina Capps may have the use of it during
her Widowhood without any Interruption of either of the said Children and
Lastly I constitute and appoint my aforesaid loving Wife and my friend Ab-
ner Whitehurst my Sole & Whole Execu^r of this my last Will and Testament
revoking and annulling all other Wills and Testaments by me formerly
made In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this 10th Day
of Oct^r 1752
