Dimple. It. I give & bequeath unto my two sons Edward & John Carroway my hand mill between them. It. I give
& bequeath unto my three youngest children on all 4. of my Estate movable & Immoveable that is not already
given by this my last will & Testament that may can or shall be called unto to be equally divided between them
when they shall come of age or day of marriage only that my son Edward & John Carroway shall have 4.

 y^e said Elizabeth Land married with Luke Hill Dec: that his wife y^e said daughter of Mary Land
 which came down with him & his wife & further saith not
