 upon called by y^e name of Dogwood ridge also I give & bequeath unto Ditt^r: one half for of two years
 to be delivered to him soon after my decease also I give unto my son John one small gun
 also I give & bequeath unto my son John one feather bed & bolster to be delivered to him when
 he comes of age for him. also I give & bequeath to my son William Dauloy two hundred acres of
 land more or less called by y^e name of Sassafras ridge also I give unto my son W^m: Dauloy one fath^r
 bed & bolster to be delivered to him when he comes of age of twenty one years also I give unto
 Ditt^r: one young yeeling to be delivered to him presently after my decease also I give & bequeath
 unto Ditt^r: one gun called by y^e name of buck also I give & bequeath unto my son W^m: Dauloy
 one young sow to be delivered to him at y^e age of twelve years - It I give & bequeath unto
 my son Thomas Dauloy two hundred acres of land more or less lying on beachon ridge & white oak

Plains also I give unto my Son Tho: one gun also I give boguath unto my son Tho: & first fold that my
old mare brings: - I give boguath unto my son Hen: Dauley two hundred acres of land adjoining to Rich

to be delivered to her shortly after my decease: also I give boguath unto my Daughter Mary Mountain
one cow & to her Daughter Margrith Mountain one cow calf to be delivered soon after my decease. I
give unto my grand Daughter Mary woodhouse one cow calf to be delivered to her soon after my decease
I give boguath unto marstt Dauley & first fold my young mare brings to be delivered soon after my decease
I give boguath unto my Daughter Margrith one cow yearling to be delivered soon after my decease and all
rest of my estate I do give boguath unto my well beloved wife Mary Dauley during her natural life
after her decease to be divided equally amongst & said Mary's children & I do appoint my well beloved wife
Mary Dauley to be my whole & sole Exor & over this my last will & Testament to do it faithfully per
formed & to the truth of this my last will & Testament I have her unto with my hand & being in perfect a
sound mind & memory this thirteenth day of may 1719
