weak of Body but of perfect mind and Memory and calling to mind the uncertainty
of this mortal life and knowing that it is appointed once to die and have
ing a desire first to settle my worldly Affairs do make this my last Will and Testament
in manner and form following that is to say first and principally I commit my Soul
to Almighty God that gave it me and my Body to the Earth to be buried at the
Discretion of my Executors And as to what worldly Goods it hath pleased God to bless
me with I give and bequeath as follows (viz^d) I give to my loving Wife my young
grey Mare her Saddle and Bridle to her and her Heirs for ever Item I give my
Land near the North Landing all my Cattle running in Woods and my black
Mare and young Siret mare may be sold for money to pay of Discharge all
my Lawful Debts and the Remainder now and above paying the same I
give to be Equally divided between my Wife and two Children Item I give and
the rest and them part of my Estate may be Appraised and Equally divided as
before and the Children shall either be sold or kept as my Executors shall see fit and
proper Lastly I do give Nominate and Appoint Cap^t John Dorey and my loving
Wife Executors of this my Last Will and Testament. Disannulling and revoking all
former Wills or Bequeaths whatsoever In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my
hand and seal this 17th day of November 1762
