Item I give to my beloved son William Edmunds y: plantation whereon I now live being aboute forty five more or less and fifty acres of a parcel of land that I took up being a hundred acres to him & his heirs for ever. Item I give & bequeath to my son John Edmunds y: plantation in y: woods being fifty acres and fifty acres of y: land that I took up to him his heirs for ever & if my beloved son William having his due if my son William will leave y: plantation in y: woods & take it my son John to have this whereon I now live. Item I give & bequeath to my beloved son Abott Edmunds two hundred pounds in money. It. I give & bequeath to daughter Elis: Edmunds our father bed & furniture & brass chello. It. I give to my son William a bible & all my Coper tools & a grist stone & a gun. It. I give to my son John: two iron wags & a young cow. It. I give to my daughter Elis: one cow & a heifer & a yearling. It. I give to my beloved wife Mary Edmunds y: plantation whereon I now live during her life & all goods & chattels within doors & without during her widowhood & if my beloved wife Mary Edmunds should marry then my desire that all my Estate is to be equally divided they having their Equall parts as they come to age if my wife Mary die not may she is to keep all during her life. I do hereby appoint my wife Mary Edmunds to be my holot & sole Exor: a witness my hand & seal January 27 day 1719
