Item I give to my beloved son about twenty five pounds in money. It. I give to my daughter Elis Edmuns old fother bed & furniture & her litter. It. I give to my son willie a Bible & Almanac copper toles & a grist stone a gun. It. I give to my son John two iron wagons & a young cow It. I give to my daughter Elis one cow & her yearling. It. I give to my beloved wife Mary Edmuns & plantation wherein I now live during her life all goods & chattels whether dore or without during her widowhood if my beloved wife Mary Edmuns should mary again then the almy Estate is to be equally divided they having their equal parts as they come to age if my wife Mary do not marry she is to keep all during her life. I do hereby appoint my wife Mary Edmuns to be my sole Executor witness my hand & seal January 27 day 1719
