... that I do hereby give and bequeath unto the hands of
 ... through the merits of Jesus Christ my dear
 ... to be buried at the discretion of my Executors hereafter
 ... bequeath unto my son John one cow half a side in
 ... one large powder bason. - I give also with
 ... mill which is now in my son John's possession one
 ... one large powder bason one cow half one feather
 ... into belonging and one chest. - Now I give & bequeath
 ... one mill one Traupot one gun one sword one feather
 ... furniture thereunto belonging one new powder dish one new powder
 ... one chest. - Now I give & bequeath unto my daughter Mary one cow
 ... her bed with of furniture thereunto belonging one chest one small powder
 ... one large powder bason one linen spinning wheel. - Now I give & bequeath
 ... my daughter Amy one new ^{two} year old hoifer one powder dish one
 ... one powder bason one of feather. - I give the furniture thereunto belonging
 ... I give & bequeath unto my daughter Susannah one powder dish one powder bason
 ... one chest. - Now I give & bequeath unto my daughter Jane one powder dish one powder
 ... one chest. - I give also of my worldly Estate both personal and real
 ... I give & bequeath unto my loving wife Susannah (saving her dower) the
