In the Name of God Amen I John Cloufer being very sick & weak in body yet perfect
in mind & memory thanks be to god therofore I do appoint this my last will & Testament
in manner & form as followeth. - I giue & bequeath to my son Solomon Cloufer my
plantation whereon I do liue to him & his heirs or assigns my desire is that my well
beloued wife Elisabeth Cloufer be no wife & be barred of any liberty of said plantation
I giue & bequeath to my son John Cloufer a piece of woodland ground which again is
to this land I liue on to him & his heirs or assigns his brother Solomon to make use
of duun Ralston ber if he hath occasion. - I giue & bequeath to my two sons
Solomon Cloufer & John Cloufer twenty acres of land lying in & I swampt to them
and their heirs or assigns to be equally diuided in quantity & quality. I giue &
bequeath to my son Solomon Cloufer my bullet gun. I giue & bequeath to my
son John Cloufer one gun. I giue & bequeath to my son Solomon a five year old mare
I giue & bequeath to my son John Cloufer a two year old mare by first fold she bring
& raises to be a ear old I giue to my daughter Elisabeth Cloufer. I desire that all the
cattle or hogs which I haue giuen to my children hereto for should be continue
in their ward. - I giue to my daughter Anna Cloufer five shillings I giue to my daughter
Abigail Cloufer five shillings I giue to my son Joshua Cloufer five shillings. I giue
& bequeath to my well beloued wife Elisabeth Cloufer all the residue & remainder
part of my estate without doubt & within I also appointe my well beloued wife
Elisabeth Cloufer my whole sole executrix of this my last will & Testament where
unto I haue set my hand & fixt my sole this 3. Day of December 1733
