 Jesus Christ to receive full pardon for y^e same into whose hands I commit my soul & my body I give
 y^e ground from whence it was taken to be decently buryed at y^e discretion of my Ex^r hereafter named
 as for my worldly Estate wherewith it pleased god far above my deserts to bestow upon me I give
 and Dispose of y^e same after all my Just Debts & funerals Expenses first being directed in man-
 ner as follows th^t:- I give & bequeath unto my brother Anthony Richmond my great Coat
 and virgin Cloath Jacket two new downe shirts & one pair of new worsted Stockings of a British gray col-
 It. I give & bequeath unto my brother Robert Richmond my riding horse & bridle & saddle on a large Iron
 pot four large powder dishes one warming pan one feather bed & one rug all which said things are
 John Attwoods & also my guided Trunk & what is in it two basons one large dish & six plates
 It. I give unto Geo: & Robert Richmond two young cows that is a young Robt. Drarmore & all their
 future increase to be equally divided between them when that y^e said Geo: shall come of age I give
 also to y^e said Geo: Richmond one small goat It. I give & bequeath unto my brother W^m Richmond
 my mare & all her future increase for ever my crib of corn one chest that is at Tho: Attwoods & at
 that is in it excepting y^e Stockings that I have already given to my brother Anthony four deep dishes
 and two basons that is at Tho: Attwoods one little Iron pot at Robert Hoollings It. I give unto Tho:
 Attwood my large Stone Sugg containing about three gallons It. I give unto Rich: Crompton my two
 roye coats... It as for all y^e rest of my Estate that is not given by this my will I give y^e same unto my
 brother Robert Richmond whom I make ordain & constitute & appoint my whole & sole Ex^r of the
 my last will & Testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 12th day
 of February 1719.
