In the Name of God Amen, that I John Dyce of the parish of St. Andrew's County of Princeps
Anne being my wife and we both
do give & Bequeath to my son John Dyce forty acres of land which he now holds, it being de-
vised by a little run from that whereon I now live to him & his heirs for ever & also one cow and
yearling & two sheep & four head of sheep & of other stock of the furniture that belongs to it, from then
and my oldest son & daughter from further stock & others for his full part of all my Estate
for ever, & I give & Bequeath to my son John Dyce fifty acres of land whereon I now live & also
thirty acres of swamp land that I bought of James Moore to him & his heirs for ever, & also
one female horse with her increase, & I give all the rest of my Estate of all kind of nature what
soever to my well beloved wife Sarah Dyce during her widowhood to bring up my child
born with & then upon the day of marriage or otherwise if she should not marry at the
day of her death my desire is that all that is then remaining of my Estate may be equally
divided between my first children, namely John & James, Sarah & Joseph & James Dyce
or in case either of the first children should die before such time, that then the remain-
ing ones may equally divide it, & lastly, I constitute & appoint my afore-^{loving} wife
Sarah Dyce my sole & whole leg. of this my last will & Testament & nothing of a Subing all
other wills & Testaments by me formerly made, In Witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand & seal this 6 day of Jan'y 1789/so

the heirs of his body, but for want of such heirs to The Turner & the heirs of his body, & so
I give to the said son & daughter one feather bed beneath whereon I now live with two sheets & one
blanket, also two cows & yearlings, & one cow & calf, two large pewter dishes, also forty shill
in the hands of Eliza Nicholson, also one barrel of hogs wearing towards Mr. Cadwaller
also twenty five shill with all to pay my debts, & I give & Bequeath to The Turner one Negro
woman named Hannah to him & his heirs, also four cows & yearlings, also the upper bed
whereon I now lie with the furniture thereto belonging, also my riding horse known
by the name of Hazard after the ground is broken up, also two pewter dishes, also fourteen
head of hogs, also the fifth part of all my meat, also three ewe one lamb, also fifty two
shillings, in the hands of Adam Lord, & I give & Bequeath to William one one Negro
man named Tony & three cows & one calf & one head of hogs wearing at Anne Norriss, two
pewter dishes & one pewter basin, also forty shill in the hands of The Changley, also three ewe
and one lamb, also the fifth part of my meat & one feather bed & the furniture thereto, &
I give & Bequeath to Lewis Price one cow & calf & one two year old heifer, also legal head
of hogs wearing at Anne Norriss, also three pounds cash he owes me & the fifth part of
my meat, & I give & Bequeath to Jos. Gasking junr. two swamp cows & calves & two
swamp steers two years old, also three ewe two lambs, also twenty three shill in the
hands of Andrew Somers, also three ^{basins & two pewter} pewter dishes also fourteen head of hogs wearing the
Pasture neck gone hogs wearing at Mr. Biddlen, & legal shill in the hands of Mr. Norriss
I give & Bequeath to John Williamson son of Tully Worson one three year old heifer and her
increase, & I give & Bequeath to The Worson son of Tully Worson one three year old heifer of the
increase, & I give & Bequeath to Fred Worson son of Tully Worson one two year old heifer
& her increase, & I give & Bequeath to Tully Worson son of Tully Worson one two year old heifer
steer, & I give & Bequeath to Mary Worson daughter of Tully Worson two year old heifer
if they come in will to be divided between the four brother Henry Williamson, & I give
& Bequeath to Sarah Castoright daughter of Mary Barrett one cow with calf & one
yearling if alive also two ewe & one lamb, & I give to Anthony Worson four pound
cash which he owes me, & I give & Bequeath abroad of Joshua Smith with the in-
terest thereon to be equally divided among the above said Williamsons as
they shall come to age
