to be buried in a decent manner by my Ex^{rs} hereafter mentioned not doubting but that I shall receive
same again by the mighty powers of God: & for my worldly Estate I give & bequeath as followeth
I give & bequeath unto my son John noblin my plantation which I have in Lincolnshire fifty acres
land in woods more or less I give to my said son John his heirs forever lawfully begotten also I give
my said son John noblin of that mile I now have also I give unto him my said son four dows with pigg
to come to be of y^e age of sixteen also I give unto my said son John four cows & four calves three Ewes & three
lambs all to be in his possession when he comes to y^e age of sixteen. I give & bequeath unto my
daughter Mary noblin three cows & three calves farther I give unto my said daughter two Ewes and two
lambs also three dows & pigg all to be put in her possession when she comes to be of y^e age of sixteen
I give & bequeath unto my loving wife Mary noblin all y^e residue of my stock of sheep & cattle except
my draft Steers & y^e oldest pairs I want to be sold with my horse for & for by my Ex^{rs} y^e money to go to war
paying y^e two orphans of Henry Fitzgerald my wife's desire is my youngest pair of Steers to remain
in my wife's custody while they come to be about sixteen years old & then to be sold by y^e value to be
equally divided between my wife & two children I.e. Mary noblin if in case either of my child
die & then my wife is y^e other shall enjoy that part: further I give unto my loving wife to have
of hogs further my desire is after my Just Debt is paid that all my stock of hogs or what they are
sold for be equally divided between my wife & two children I.e. Mary noblin my desire is that my
plantation I now live on remain in my wife's custody during her widowhood or till my son come
to y^e age of sixteen & then my said wife to have my dwelling house & twenty thousand Corn hills at
mouth of y^e neck but if in case my wife should marry & remove of y^e plantation then my desire is my
to be possessed with y^e whole: further my wife's desire is that my wife & two children should have y^e profit
by labour of my negro man George for this eight years then if living to be sold by y^e money to be equal
divided between my wife & two children. I.e. Mary noblin I.e. is my son John noblin at y^e age of six
years shall be of age to receive his part or portion left him by me & also to have my kitchen
yard & the house I now live in & all the land out of his two uncles Geo: & William noblin I.e. I give

 is then my wife is y^e other shall enjoy that part. further I give unto my loving wife ten ke
 of hoggs further my desire is after my Just Debt is paid that all my stock of hoggs or what they a
 be sold for be equally divided between my wife & two children I^e. mary woblin my desire is that my
 plantation I now live on remain in my wife's custody during her widowhood or till my son com
 to y^e age of sixteen & then my said wife to have my dwelling house & twenty thousand Corn hills at
 mouth of y^e neck but if in case my wife should marry & remove of y^e plantation then my desire is my so
