Apparail of what kind soever it be it being his full part and portion of my
Estate. It I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Priscilla Williamson
to her and her heirs for ever the Plantation whereon she now dwells being
bounded on the one side by the West the Landing Road and on the back
by a Line of Marked trees newly made beginning from Major Tho Walkers
Line and so Extending until it meets with Col Walkers Line at the other
End of the said Line parting the said plantation from the Plantation
whereon I now live also two Cows and Calves also the bed and furniture
now Lye on & one Negro Wench called grace being in full of her part and
portion of my Estate. Item I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Mary
Matthias to her and her heirs for ever one Negro fellow called Shasper in
full of her part and portion of my Estate. Item I give unto my Daughter
Sarah Matthias to her and her heirs for ever my Negro Wench called Jenny
and her three children Hato Shasper and her Sucking Infant in full
of her part and portion of my Estate I give and bequeath unto my
Daughter Betty Shepherd to her and her heirs for ever Two Cows &
Calves, Two heifer Yearlings Two Sows and Pigs my Riding horse
Bridles and Saddle One Cupboard three Chairs My Iron bound Chair
in full of her part and portion of my Estate. It I give and bequeath unto
my Son John Williamson to him and his heirs for ever the Plantation
whereon I now live to Extend from the above now mentioned new made
Line mentioned in my Grant to my Daughter Priscilla including part
of Edwards patents being the remainder of my said Land before given
to my Daughter Priscilla Williamson also one Negro fellow called Abby
Item My Wife and I desire is that after my Lawful Debt lawfully Satis-

of the sum of five Shillings current money of Virginia to him in
hand paid by the said Lushorn Nimmo the receipt whereof he hereby
acknowledgeth hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents
doth Grant Bargain and sell unto the aforesaid Lushorn Nimmo all that
piece or parcel of Land containing part of an Acre Situate and being
in the Parish of Lynhaven and County of Princeps Assn^t as
the same is marked off and bounded by the said parties hereunto
attorneth, five and a quarter Chains from a Chinkerspen Stake along the
road that leads to Fungo to a Chinkerspen Stake from thence Eastward
and thirty two feet Southwardly to another Chinkerspen Stake from thence
five and a quarter Chains to a Gum off from thence One hundred and
Thirty two feet to the first mentioned Chinkerspen Stake it being one half
of an Acre of Land Edward Moseley bought of James Fentiffe and
the Reversion and Reversions Remained and Remainders Rents Issues
and profits thereof To have and to hold the said piece or parcel
