Estate. Item I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Priscilla Williamson
to her and her heirs for ever the Plantation wheron she now liveth being
bounded on the one side by the North Landing Road and on the back
by a Line of Marsh trees newly made beginning from Major the Walkers
line and so extending until it meets with Col Walker Line at the other
end of the said Line parting the aforesaid plantation from the Plantation
wheron I now live also two Cows and Calves also the bed and furniture
now Lys and one Negro Woman called gracie being in full of her part and
portion of my Estate. Item I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Mary
Mathias to her and her heirs for ever one Negro fellow called Sharper in
full of her part and portion of my Estate. Item I give unto my Daughter
Sarah Mathias to her and her heirs for ever one Negro Woman called Jenny
and her three children Kate Sharper and her Suckling Infant in full
of her part and portion of my Estate I give and bequeath unto my
Daughter Sally Shepherd to her and her heirs for ever Two Cows &
Calves, Two hosen Yearlings Two Sons and Two young Riding horse
bridles and Saddles One Cupboard three Chairs My Iron bound Chest

Between Edward Hatch Moseley of the County of Princ^eps Anne or the one
part and Gresham Nimmo of the afores^t County of the other Part Hatching
eth That the said Edward Hatch Moseley for and in consideration
of the sum of five Shillings current money of Virginia to him in
hand paid by the said Gresham Nimmo the receipt whereof he hereby
acknowledgeth hath Granted bargained and sold and by these presents
do Grant Bargain and sell unto the afores^t Gresham Nimmo all that
piece or parcel of Land containing part of an Acre situate and lying
in the Parish of Lynnhaven and County of Princ^eps Anne afores^t
the same is marked off and bounded by the said parties hereunto
followeth, first and a quarter Chain from a Chinkopen Stake along the
road that leadeth to pungs to a Chinkopen Stake from thence One hundred
and thirty two feet Southwesterly to another Chinkopen Stake from thence
four and a quarter Chain to a Gum (from thence) One hundred and
thirty two feet to the first mentioned Chinkopen Stake it being one half
of an Acre of Land Edward Hatch Moseley bought of James Fentife and
the Execution and Reversion Remained and Remainders Rents &
and profits thereof To have and to hold the said piece or parcel
of Land and premises with all land singular the appurtenances
unto the said Gresham Nimmo his Executors Administrators and
signs from the Day before the Day of the Date hereof for and during the
full and term of twelve months from thence next ensuing and fully
to be completed and ended to the intent that by virtue hereof and of
the Statute for transforming leases into possession the said Gresham Nimmo

 der, to Robert Patterson of the County of Prince Anne in the Colony of Virginia & am
 given to be my true and Lawful Attorney for me and in my Name and to
 my own proper Use Benefit and behoof to make demand of payment due for and
 recover and receive all such Debts Duties Lards and sums of Money Rent &
 Rents Yearly payment to Legacies Monys due upon Day Bills of Exchange
 and all other Demands and dues whatsoever as now are or here after shall
 become due and payable belonging or to be delivered unto me the said Mark Powell
 by or from any person or persons whatsoever and Contract for sale and Convey and
 Dispose all or any of my Messuages Lands Tenements or Headments what-
 soever and for Default of Payment or Delivery of any sum or sums of Money
 or other things due or to be due or belonging to me to use all Lawfull Ways &
 Means for the recovery thereof by Action suit, Plaintiff, Defe[n]dant, Entry or Other
 ways as fully and amply in all and every respect as my self might or could
 do if I were personally present and to sue, implead make Answer, Prosecute
 and Defend in any Court of Law or Equity and before any Judge or Justice
 in any Suit Matter or Cause with me for me or against me as the cause shall
 require to deal & intermeddle in all Actions suits Affairs or Businesse & Wayes
 touching or concerning me or any Agent or Factor or otherwise giving and by these
 presents granting to any said Attorney full & whole Lawfull Authority in the Ex-
