I, Jonathan Mackey of the County of Princess Anne & State of Virginia, being of sound mind & Memory & Imprimis I give and bequeath to my Son Henry Mackey one bay Mare nam'd Pidgon a Sorrel Horse call'd Practice, two young bay Horses, now in his possession, three Cows & Calves, Six head of Sheep, one Bed & furniture to him & his Heirs forever. Item. I give to my Son John Mackey one Sorril Mare call'd Peggy, four young Stears One Cow & Yearling, my Plantation after his Mothers death to him & his Heirs forever. Item. I give and bequeath to my loving Wife Elizabeth my Plantation, my Negro man name John. all my Stock & other property not already given, to her dureing her life, & after her dec. to be equally divided amongst all my Children, she paying all my Just debts & supporting my youngest Children untill they come of age or Marry. I appoint my loving Wife Elizabeth Lemuel Cornick & my Son John Mackey, Executors to this my last Will & Testament
