 ordained this last will & Testament as followeth: I give my land and hundred
 acres to be equally divided between my two sons William & Joseph Offerson
 the norward part to William my plantation with land to Joseph: I give my
 marsh that is on my fresh pond land to my son William Offerson lying on the
 South end of the Island I give to my son William four head of cattle with their in-
 crease & my bay mare Except a first colt that she shall bring that I give to
 my son Joseph: I give to my loving wife whom I make my Executrix of this
 my last will & Testament all my whole Estate that is not above mentioned
 both within doors & without doors as witness my hand

 mind & memory praised be God for it do make & ordaine & appoint this my last
 will & Testament manner & form following viz: I give & bequeath my
 soul into the hands of almighty God hoping to be saved through the merits of
 Jesus Christ my lve. blessed redemer & my body to if death to be decently
 buried at the discretion of my Executor hereafter named: I am that all my
 debts & funerall charges be contented & paid: I am I give & bequeath to my well
 beloved son John Camberfoot all my Tract & plantation of land whereon I
 now live containing one hundred acres to him & his heirs for ever not mis-
 ing his mother during her widowhood: and as for the rest of my Estate
 both personal & real I give & bequeath to be equally divided amongst my wife
 and children & my will is that my wife shall have the use of all my Estate during
