 return to my children to be Equally divided among them all ~ I give all my negre
 that shall be living with their increase at y^e time of my daughter marg^t Tholaba
 being at age or at the Day of her marriage to be Equally divided among my four
 children Robert, margret Horiah & Mary Tholaball & also of child my wife's
 with child with to have its equal share of y^e said negroes & my will & desire is that m
 negro man Cook to be sold & another negro purchased with the money to goe in the
 lot amongst the rest ~ my will is that if in case I have no son that live to
 have heirs of their body that my Daughter margret shall have my Land before
 mentioned to my son Robert ~ I do hereby appoint & ordain my loving wife
 Doyce Tholaball my whole & sole Ex^r of this my last will & Testament to make in
 & disanuling all former wills & Testaments Ratifying & Confirming this & no other
 but this to be my last will & Testament In witness whereof I have hereunto se
 my hand & seal the day & year above written
