 for ever Item I give and bequeath unto my Son Arthur Sayer One pair of my best
 draught Cloes to him and his heirs for ever Item I give and bequeath unto my
 Grand Daughters Anne and Margaret Newton the Sum of fifteen Pounds Current
 money and all my Wearing Cloths to be equally divided between them as they
 shall respectively attain the Age of Eighteen years Old or marry to them the
 said Anne and Margaret Newton and their heirs for ever. Item I give and
 bequeath unto my Daughter Frances Brash my Gold Sleeve buttons to her
 and heirs for ever. Item I give and bequeath unto my Grandson Anth^m
 Lawton my Mourning ring to him and his heirs for ever. Item I give and
 bequeath unto my Granddaughter Margaret Walke One Mourning ring to
 be purchased by my Executor to her and heirs for ever. Item I give and bequeath
 unto my granddaughter Frances Sayer the Sum of Seven Pounds and
 Ten Shillings Current money to her and her heirs for ever. Item I give and
 bequeath unto my Granddaughter Margaret Brash the Sum of Seven Pounds
 and ten Shillings Current money to her and her heirs for ever. Item I give and
 bequeath all the residue and remaining part of my Estate unto my Son Arthur
 Sayer my Daughter Frances Brash and the Children of my Daughter Elizabeth
 Newton dead in manner following unto my Son Arthur Sayer One third
 part of my Estate, not yet given in this Will, unto my Daughter Frances Brash
 one third part of my Estate in the same manner and the remaining third
 part of my Estate I give unto the Children of my Daughter Elizabeth New-
 ton to them, the said Arthur Sayer, Frances Brash and my Grand Children
 as before menconed and to their heirs for ever Lastly I do hereby Nominate
 and Appoints my Son Arthur Sayer Exec^r of this my Last Will and Testament
 In Witness Whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this 18 day
 of May 1754
