This Indenture made the fourteenth Day of August in the year of Our Lord One thousand seven hundred and fifty four Between Henry Consalvo of the County of Princeps one of the one part and William Holmes of the Same place of the other part Witnesseth that the said Henry Consalvo for and in consideration of the Sum of five Shillings to him in hand paid by the said William Holmes the receipt Whereof he doth hereby acknowledge hath bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain and sell unto the said William Holmes One certain Tract or parcel of Land containing by Estimation One hundred Acres more or less (being the same Land that was bought of Francis Consalvo by William Consalvo jun^r as p^r Deeds bearing date the 14th & 15th days of August 1749 will appear And all Houses Buildings Orchards Ways Waters profits and Appurtenances whatsoever to the the said premises hereby granted or any part thereof belonging or in any wise appertaining) And the Reversion and Reversions Remainder and Remainders Rents Issues and profits thereof To have & to hold the said one hundred Acres of Land and all and singular other the premises hereby granted with the appurtenances unto the said William Holmes his heirs Executors & Assigns from the Day of the Date hereof for and during the full term and time of one whole year from thence next ensuing and fully to be completed and ended to the intent that by Virtue of these presents and of the Statute for Granting uses into possession the said William Holmes may be in the actual possession of the premises and be enabled to accept and take a Grant and Release
