This Indenture made the thirtieth Day of December in the year of our Lord One thousand Seven hundred and fifty four Between William Godfrey of the County of Princeps Anne of the one part and James Whitehurst of the same place Shipwright of the other part Witnesseth That the said William Godfrey for and in Consideration of the sum of Five pounds Current money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said James Whitehurst at and before the Enrolling and Delivery of these presents the Receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge and thereof and from every part of the same doth acquit and discharge the same James Whitehurst his heirs Executors & Administrators With Joyntia Bargain and Sale already released and Confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain Sell alien release & Confirm unto the said James Whitehurst one certain piece of Land containing by Estimation five Acres of Land more or Less situate Lying and being in the County afores^d and is a small piece of that Land that the above William Godfrey purchased of George Olden as
