In the Name of God Amen, 4. fourteenth day of November in 4. year of our Lord God 1718: I me
as moor of pines for the County Virg. Taylor being sick & weak of body but in perfect mind & memory
thanks be given unto God therofore calling unto mind 4. mortality of my body & knowing that is appointed
at me to die I do make & ordain this my last will & Testament in manner & form following that is to
first & principally I give my soul into 4. hands of God who gave it me: & for my body I commend it to the
earth to be buried in Christian & decent manner nothing doubting but at 4. general resurrection I shall
rise again: by 4. mighty power of God & as touching such worldly estate where with I am
God to bless me in this life I give & devise by word & deed as I am in manner & form following
I give unto my well beloved son: Sam. moor one good feather bed & bolster three blankets & rug
all to be to it with a mare of three years old & two ewes & lambs & an Iron pot to be paid to 4. Sam. moor
when he comes to 4. age of Twenty one years: - I give & devise by word & deed my Daughter Oliver moor
a book three years old with a calf & two ewes & lambs to be paid to 4. Oliver moor when she comes
to 4. age of 14 years: - I give & devise by word & deed to my well beloved wife Elizabeth moor all goods
my personal estate that she shall have me & I make & ordain my well beloved wife Elizabeth moor my full
sole Exor. & Ador. hereby I make & ordain & appoint all & every other former Testament with Legacies
made & by me in any way before this time made & devised & confirmed this now to be
to be my last will & Testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 14. day of November
1718
