 to be read my last will & Testament I begueth my soul to almighty God my Creator hoping & Trusting that by his
 mercies of my Saviour Jesus Christ I receive pardon & forgiveness of all my sins & my body to be sent
 to be decently buried at the discretion of my Ex. hereafter named & after taking full debts & of funeral Expenses
 repaid & discharged I give my worldly goods & estate as follows I give & bequeath to my Daughter Elizabeth
 my grandy on large feather bed & bolster & sheet & good blow rug & blanket & two dishes & two plates and a
 small looking glass & on large Iron pot & spit & a gun & a chest to her & heirs for ever I give & bequeath
 to my Daughter Mary & heirs I give & bequeath to my wife & Daughter my stock of female Cattel
 only & my wife to have & manage & her Daughter to have & manage & equally divided & for the
 Spring after my death to them & their heirs for ever I give & bequeath to my Daughter Elizabeth
 hundred acres of land that I bought of Henry Simmons that is in a Swamp out a hundred acres of land that
 was formerly Robert Richmond to her & heirs for ever but in carrying Daughter dies without issue
 full heirs then to return to my brother in law William Benson to her & heirs for ever I give & bequeath
 unto my wife Mary my grandy all singular & remainder of my estate personal & real to her & her heirs
 for ever & do hereby nominate & appoint for my said wife my whole debt & of this my last will and
 Testament witnesses whom I have hereunto set my hand & Seal this Eighteenth Day of January
 in the year of our Lord God 1718
