First I will that all my just debts be Contented and paid. It I Give & Bequeath to
my son James Malbone the plantation & now live on to a division already
made between him & his brother Phillip Containing by estimation One
Hundred & Eighty acres more or less to him & his heirs for ever, up on Condition
on my son James will acknowledge all his right of One hundred & thirty
lands that I hold in Carvers woods when Requested to my son Jonathan
& his heirs for ever at Jonathan cost, otherwise for James to keep the hundred
& thirty acres & Jonathan to have that I now live on. I likewise give to my
son James all that he has in possession that is called his. It I Give to my
son Phillip Malbone One hundred acres of land more or less according
to the bounds already laid off to him & his heirs for ever; I likewise give to my
son Phillip three Cows two calves & one heifer, one of the Cows & the heifer
being now called his. It I Give to my son Jonathan the first sole that my mare
brings, I Give to my son Peter Malbone of land in braken Ridge joining
to John Hoints & the next sole my Mare brings. I Give to all my sons, James
Phillip, Jonathan, Peter, Malchus, Solomon, & John Malbone all my land
& marshes Equally amongst them as a privilege for their down stock. It
I Give to my beloved wife Mary Malbone the use of all the rest of my lands
during her wid^d hood & then to be Equally divided between my wife & children
I likewise appoint my wife & son James my sole & sole heirs of this my
Last will and Testament, Revoking & disannulling all other wills & Testaments
by me formerly made In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand &

An Inventory of the Estate of ~~James~~ Plev. Malbone Decided. To Two Hides down
 or twelve Tuns of sack. Ten heads of Cattle three of them hung Cattle. Eight head of sheep &
 five Lambs. Eleven hogs & seven Hogs. four Tables. three Chaises one Box. One horse with
 Eight Bottles. and one Box Bottles three feather Beds and some other feather Sixteen
 flax Chairs and one Sofa. four Lin. Whels and one Wooden Wheel. four Stewed Pickers
 three Brooms and five plates. three Dag and six spoons. new ones & nine other Dittos
 three Iron Stoves and Iron Kettles and frying Pan. and one Looking Glass two Jugs two
 Mugs one punch bowl and a butter pot with small old books and one Sticks & one Loom
 and one pair of Shears and seven Stays one Earthen Plate. To Two Ceyden hogheads
 and two Barrels and two Anchors and two Powdering Tubbs one back. one One Legger
