pleased God to send me with I give & bequeath as followeth vizt --- I give & bequeath to George
Thompe my loving Landlord & to his heirs for ever my horse saddle & furniture together with all the
my estate whatsoever of what kind so ever it be to him & his heirs I give & leave for ever after my Just
debts & funeral Charges are paid whom I also Ordain my Exor to perform this my last will & Testament
