I have I leave a small parcel of land which I bought of John Richason to be sold to help to pay my debts: as for part of my Estate after my debts is paid I give to my well beloved wife Sarah Franklin & her children but nothing to be forced from her during her widowhood but if she marry then to be equally divided amongst all appointing my wife & son Thomas Franklin jointly together to be whole & sole Executors of this my last will & Testament and for y validity whereof I have affixed my hand & seal this 7th day of September 1719:

The Franklin & Seal

In the name of God Amen the 19th day of October 1723: I Peter Oliver of the County of princeps Anne Carpenter being very sick & weak in body but of perfect mind & memory thanks be to God almighty: by the sword calling to mind the mortality of my body knowing it is appointed for all men once to die do make & ordain this my last will & Testament that is to say principally & first of all I give and recommend my soul into y hands of God that giveth & for my body I commend it to y earth to be buried in a decent & Christian like manner at the discretion of my Exor hereafter named nothing doubting to receive y same at y General resurrection by the mighty power of God: & as for such worldly Estate as it hath pleased God to Endue me with I give & bequeath as followeth Viz^t: I give & bequeath to George Tompe my loving land lord to his heirs for ever my house & all the furniture together with all other my Estate whatsoever of what kind or sort so ever it be to him and his heirs I give & leave for ever after my Just debts & funeral charges are paid whom I also ordain my Exor to perform this my last will & Testament as witness my hand the day & year first above written
