pigg. I doo I give & bequeath my son Rich^d Capps two shillings. I doo I give & bequeath all y^e
rest of my Estate to my wol-boloud wife margrot Capps & I make my wife margrot my whole
sole execut^r and I make my ^{four} young at age at eight or nine years old.
