Estates as god in mercy hath bestowed upon me I giue & bequeath the followeth in Imp^t. I giue an
bequeath my Lande Tenements & plantation whereon I now liue & all
maners therunto belonging to my two Sons John & Richard Corbet to
Ever and my wile & soires that noither of my two Sons In^r. or Rich^r.
Lease out or mortgage his or either of thoir parts of y^e said Land & be-
whatsoever unto to each other or by each other of free consent but that y^e said Land & be-
divided betwixt them when my said Son Rich^r. shall come of age & if either of my said Sons shall
sold or do otherwise then my aforesaid wile I disinherit him of all his part of y^e said Land & giue
it to the other Son. - I now I giue & bequeath my negro woman Phillis & all her increase Except
two of the first children of her increase that shall be born & live to be two year old each of
them which two children as aforesaid I giue to my daughter Abigail Corbet & all thoir increase
(and y^e said negro woman as aforesaid to my daughter Mary Corbet with all her increase but if in
case either of my two Daughters die leaving no Issue of thoir bodies then my wile is that y^e other
Sister shall have her part of y^e said negro to her & her heirs for Ever; - I giue & bequeath y^e Labour
of y^e aforesaid negro woman Phillis, notwithstanding y^e gift aforesaid to my loving wife Francis
Corbet during her naturall life but not to be manumitted or carryed out of this County to live. if
she be my daughter to take the immediate possession of her. I also giue to my said wife all the
rest of my Estate towards the paying of all my Just debts & if bringing up of my children
I giue to Thomas Williamson Son of In^r. Williamson one year old male Child to be delivered him
within one year after my decease to make Francis my wife my sole Ex^r of this my last
will & Testament to which I have set my hand & seal this 12th Day of October 1720
