it is my will that after all my lawfull debts be paid what is left of my Estate be equally divided
between my Sister Mary Brock & Margaret Brock & Mary Brock Daughter of my friend James & Mary
Item after my Decease I do appoint my brother in law James Brock & my Sister Mary Brock to be
my whole executors of this my last will & Testament whereto I have set my hand & fixed my
Seal this Second Day of October anno Domini 1716
