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In the Name of God Amen I Richard Moy of princesse Anne County being very sick
& weak but of perfect mind & memory & calling to mind y^e mortality of man kind
that we are all born to Dye I mynima in the first place I give my s^ols to the hands of
God that gave it me not doubting but I shall receive it at y^e day of resurrection and
my body to be buried in a Christian & decent manner at y^e will of my Ex^x as touching
my worldly Estate as it has ben pleased God to Indue me with I give & bequeath to
my well beloved wifemary moy all the use & profits of my whole Estate both real &
personall during her lifetime my will & desire is that if my well beloved wifemary
should have a child lawfully begotten during her lifetime it may enjoy y^e one half of
my whole Estate both real & personal to him & his heirs for ever but if in case my said
wife do decease without issue or if she lawfully begotten of her body I give the said land
plantation I now dwell on & with all the premises to my kinsman John Raley the
son of Thomas Raley & Mary his wife to him & his heirs for ever I give & bequeath
to my well beloved brother George moy all y^e rest of my Estate both real & personal
after my s^ols & funerall charges is payd & I do constitute & appoint my Ex^x and
well beloved wifemary my whole s^ols Ex^x of this my last will & Testament In witness
whereof I have hereunto set my hand & s^ols this ninth day of February and in the
year of our Lord Christ one thousand & thirty & three
