I give & bequeath my soul into the hands of almighty God that gaud it in hoping that at y^e general resurrection
to receive y^e same again by y^e mighty power of God: & my body to its mother earth to be decently buried at the
discretion of my Exors hereafter named & as for my worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased almighty God to
bless me with in this life I give & bequeath in manner & form following: -- Item I give & bequeath to my
son Roger William one negro man named Robin to him & y^e heirs lawfully begotten of his body for ever after y^e
decease of my wife but if she intermarry then my said son to have y^e said negro immediately at y^e day of her mar-
riage I give to my said son Roger one negro girl named Nan to him & y^e heirs lawfully begotten of his body
for ever together with all y^e increase of y^e said negro, I give to my said son Roger all my wearing apparel of both
linen & woollen. -- It. I give to my son John William one negro woman named Ed together with the
increase of y^e said negro from y^e date of this my will to him & y^e heirs lawfully begotten of his body for ever
but my wife to have y^e use of y^e said Negro during her widowhood but if my wife marry then my said son
to have & receive y^e said negro at y^e day of marriage. I give to my said son John one Tract of Land which
I bought of Cap^t William Craford Joyning to y^e land he now lives on containing sixty acres or thereabouts
I give & bequeath unto my son Bartholomew William one Negro boy named Harry which negro he
hath now in his possession to him my said son & y^e heirs lawfully begotten of his body for ever. -- Item
I give & bequeath to my son George William one negro named Robin being son of y^e said Robin before
given to my son Roger to him & y^e heirs lawfully begotten of his body for ever immediately after my decease
I give to my said son Geo^y plantation wherison I now dwell & that my wife do not disturb my said son
wher he now dwells & that my said wife & son have y^e orchard betwixen them as it is now divided -- It. I give
to my granddaughter Mary William daughter of my son Geo^y William one negro girl named Hannah
all her increase to her my said granddaughter & y^e heirs lawfully begotten of her body for ever. -- It. I give
to my daughter Mary Berry wife of Robert Berry one parcel of Land & other appurtenances thereto be-
longing bounding on y^e plantation I now live upon & Geo^y Shirley his plantation y^e said land being
marked round to her my said Daughter & her heirs. I give to my said Daughter one negro girl named
Pegg which said negro is now in y^e possession of my said Daughter & y^e increase of y^e said negro to be equally
divided amongst y^e children of my said Daughter Mary. -- It. I give to my daughter Sarah wife of Mathew
Mathias one negro boy named Tom which she hath now in y^e possession to her my said Daughter & y^e heirs lawfully
begotten of her body for ever. -- It. I give to my grandson Caleb son of my daughter Ann which she hath one
negro girl named Ann with her increase to my said grandson & y^e heirs of his body for ever. -- It. I give to

 I giue to my said son Geo: y^e plantation whereon I now dwel & that my wife do not disturb my said son
 where she now dwel & that my said wife & son haue y^e orchard betwosen thomas it is now diuided - It I giue
 to my grand daughter mary williamson daughter of my son Geo: w^{ch} son on one negro girl named Hannah
 w^{ch} her in cross to her my said grand daughter & y^e heirs lawfully begotten on her body for ever - It I giue
 to my daughter mary Berry wife of Robert Berry one parcel of land & other appurtenances thereto be-
 longing bounding on y^e plantation I now liue upon & Geo: Shirley his plantation & said land being
 marked round to her my said Daughter & her heirs - I giue to my said Daughter one negro girl named
 Pegg which said negro is now in y^e possession of my said Daughter & y^e heirs of y^e said negro to be equally
 diuided amongst y^e children of my said Daughter mary: - It I giue to my daughter Sarah wife of Mathew
 Mathias one negro boy named Jemmy which she hath now in possession to her my said Daughter & y^e heirs lawfully
 begotten on her body for ever - It I giue to my grand son Calb son of my daughter Anne which she hath one
 negro girl named Jemmy with her in cross to my said grand son & y^e heirs of his body for ever - It I giue to
 daughter Anne which she hath wife of Hugh Whitshurst and mollatto slave to her my said Daughter & to her
 disposal: - It I giue to my son Geo: w^{ch} on my hand mill my wife to haue y^e use of it during her wid-
 hood - It I giue to my loving wife mary williamson my best bed & furniture & my riding horse -
 And as for y^e remaining part of my Estate my will is that it shall be diuided betwosen my wife mary
 my sons Roger John Bartho: & George & my daughters mary Sarah & Ann by them to be diuided as well
 what is with in door as without of what kind or quality so ever: - And I do hereby nominate appoint
 and ordaine my son Bartho: & my son Geo: williamson to be my whole & sole Exors of this my last will
 & Testament revoking & annulling all former wills & Testaments by me at any time heretofore made
 Ratifying & confirming & allowing this to be my last will & Testament & none other In witness
 & further Testimony whereof I haue hereunto set my hand & seal
