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In the Name of God Amen 4th Day of May in the year of our Lord God 1719. I Robert Bray in County of Princess Anne being Sick & weak in body but of perfect mind & memory thanks be given to god therefore taking unto mind 4th mortality of my body & knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die do make & ordain this my last will & Testament that is to say principally & first of all I give & recommend my soule into 4th hands of god that gave it & for my body I commend it to 4th earth to be buried in a Christianlike & decent manner at 4th discretion of my Ex^{rs} hereafter named nothing doubting to receive 4th soul at 4th general resurrection by 4th mighty power of God as touching such worldly estate wherewith it hath pleased god to lend me I give devise & dispose of 4th same in 4th following manner & forms: my Just debts being paid I give 4th same as followeth I give & bequeath to my loving wife my riding horse & one negro man called goo: & one negro girl called moll during her life & after her decease my negro fellow goo: to my son Plomer & his heirs & likewise my negro girl called moll to my daughter Mary Bray to her & her heirs forever & her increase my negro girl moll to be delivered to my daughter Mary when she comes of age or married & likewise my negro: goo: to my son plomer when he comes to age after my wifes decease I give & bequeath to my loving wife Iacomin Bray eighty eight acres of land lying in 4th woods binding upon 4th negro Swamp & after my wifes decease 4th said Tract of land eighty eight acres to fall to my son plomer I also give unto my wife two gold rings: I give unto my son plomer one gold ring 4th part of it (remember 4th giver) I also give unto my daughter Mary one gold ring: I also I give & bequeath to my loving wife all my stock of cattle & hogs & mowables & immowables I also leave two Draft Steers to be sold for money to pay my debts I give unto my brother in law In. wishard two Sows & one pigge belonging to 4th little pond I make & ordain my loving wife Iacomin Bray to be my whole & sole Ex^{rs}: of this my last will & Testament as witness my hand & fixed my Seale

At a Court hold the 5th of August 1719
Then 4th within last will of m^r. Robert
Bray dec. was presented in Court by his Ex^{rs} &
who made oath thereto & being proved by 4th oaths
of all 4th witnesses thereto is admitted to Record
