

This Indenture made this fourth day of October in the year of our Lord God one thousand seven hundred twenty six between Thomas Thorowgood of Prince of Ann County in virginia of the one part & William Parsons of Norfolk County of the other part witnesseth that I said Thomas Thorowgood for & in consideration of the sum of Ten pounds, Curr: money to him in hand paid by thos: william Parsons the receipt whereof he & said Thomas Thorowgood doth hereby acknowledge have bargained & sold by these presents to bargain & sell unto of said william Parsons one lot or parcel of land (with a house erected thereon) Situate lying & being at the point at New Town in Prince of Ann County containing half an acre of land to have and to hold of said one lot or half acre of land as before expressed unto of said william Parsons his heirs executors administrators & assigns with all singular & other the profits & hereditam before mentioned & intended to be hereby granted bargained & sold with their & every of their appurtenances from the day before the date hereof for & during the term of one whole year from thence next ensuing fully to be completed and delivered yeilding & paying therefor the yearly tont of one pound current of St John of baptist only if the same be lawfully demanded to & intent that by virtue of these presents of the Statute for Transferring uses into possession of said william Parsons may be in the actual possession of the premises above mentioned except a grant of the reversione inheritance thereof to him & his heirs An witness whereof of said Thomas Thorowgood hath hereunto set his hand & seal the day & year first above written

This Indenture made this third Day of October in the year of our Lord God one thousand seven hundred Twenty six Between Thomas Thorowgood of Prince of Ann County in virginia of the one part & william Parsons of Norfolk County of the other part witnesseth that I said Thomas Thorowgood for & in consideration of the sum of five Shillings good currant & lawful money to him in hand paid by of said william Parsons at or before the sealing & delivery of these presents & receipt whereof he & said Tho: Thorowgood doth hereby acknowledge & himself therewith fully satisfied & contented and paid to them & every part & parcel thereof doth clearly & absolutely acquit themselves & discharge him of said william Parsons his heirs & me & every of them forever by these presents hath given granted bargained alienated & confirmed & by these presents doth give grant bargain & alienate to & to his heirs & assigns a certain lot or parcel of land containing half an acre with a house erected thereon Situate lying & being at the point at New Town in Prince of Ann County all which I said promises are in the actual possession of him & said william Parsons & all the estate right interest in property termes & conditions claim & demand unto ever of him & said Thomas Thorowgood & every other person whatsoever to the promise & every part & parcel thereof by & over these presents remainder & remainder & all other rents & profits & the promises of every part & parcel thereof together with all singular debts & wills & donees writings & records whatsoever touching or concerning the said promises to have & to hold of said lot or parcel of land with their & every of their appurtenances unto of said william Parsons his heirs & assigns to them only proprietors & behalfe of him & said W: Parsons his heirs & assigns for ever & said Tho: Thorowgood his heirs & assigns of said mentioned grants promises with their appurtenances unto his will. Parsons his heirs & assigns against all other persons whatsoever shall & will warrant & for ever defend by these presents by said Tho: Thorowgood for himself his heirs executors administrators & bouny of them both & common grant & agree to with of said william Parsons his heirs & assigns to every of them by these presents in manner & form following that is to say that it shall & may be lawful to & for him & said william Parsons his heirs & assigns from time to time at all times hereafter according to true purport intent & meaning of these presents lawfully & quietly to enter into & upon have & hold occupy & enjoy to his & their properties & behalfe of the aforesaid mentioned lot or tract of land & all singular other promises herein before mentioned more or less intended to be hereby granted all in & not to be altered or confirmed & every part & parcel thereof with their appurtenances without any lawful let & hindrance or delay either by himself or his heirs or assigns or any other person or persons whatsoever claiming or to claim any estate right title interest of in or out of of the same or any part thereof that is said Tho: Thorowgood hath no right & power lawfully to do or to possess of the said land or premises to which william Parsons his heirs & assigns as aforesaid in witness whereof of the Tho: Thorowgood have hereunto set his hand & seal the day & year first above written
