In the Name of God Amen I Sarah Hutchings wid^d of princ^{ess} Anne County being
 in a very weak & Low Condition of body but of a sound & disposing mind praised
 be God for it & knowing that it is appointed once for all to Dissolve being very desirous to
 settle peace & unity betw^{een} my Children for the further strengthening and Con-
 firming my husbands will do make & appoint this to be my last will & Testament
 in manner following - first I bequeath my soul to a mighty God who gave
 it me trusting that through the merit of my blessed Saviour Jesus Christ to receive
 full pardon of all my sins at the last day & my body to the earth to be decently buried at
 y^e discretion of my Exor hereafter named & for my worldly Estate I bequeath as follows
 I give & bequeath unto my son Nathaniel Hutchings my negro slave called David to
 him and his heirs for ever: - I give & bequeath unto my two sons John & Nathan
 Hutchings my five Slaves by name Sue, Peter, Betty, Polly & Joe to be Equally divided
 betw^{een} them to whom I am to to their heirs for ever, - I give & bequeath to my
 son Nathaniel Hutchings all the money in his hands to him & his heirs for ever -
 Lastly I nominate and appoint Nathaniel Hutchings to my whole Exor of this my
 last will & Testament In witness whereof I have set my hand & seals this 2^d day of
 December 1729. -

 of the Eastern Shore in the County of princ^{ess} Anne in this Colony and Dominion of
 Virginia send greeting in our Lord God everlasting Know ye that I y^e said Elizabeth
 White for the Love & affection that I y^e said Elizabeth White do bare unto James White my son
 I y^e said Elizabeth White being in perfect memory have given granted & Confirmed & by this
 present writing do fully freely & absolutely give grant & Confirm unto my aforesaid son
 James White that is today one mill one case of bottles one two year old keifer to have &
 To hold use take and Enjoy the aforesaid goods unto y^e said James White his heirs
 administ^r & assigns from hence forth for ever without any manner of claim chal-
 lunge or demand whatsoever, and I the said Elizabeth White all this in full & aforesaid
 goods unto y^e said James White
