In the Name of God Amen I Sarah
Jones being sick of Body but of sound
memory calling to mind that it is to make
this my last Will & Testament in manner
Form following Viz. I my heirs & assigns
to Robert Holmes and Wife during their
natural lives the plantation whereon
they now live lying to the Northward & Westward
of the Road, I also give unto the said Robert
one third part & the other which was his
his own to him & his heirs forever. I then
give to my Daughter & her Daughter
now Wife of Johnson Kinross all the Land
on the East and South side of the Road and
joining her the said Johnson's own Land
also I give Negro Man named Peter and one
Negro Woman & her named Merriah &
all to her and her heirs for ever. I then
give to Mary Old Daughter of Johnson
one Negro Girl called Judith to her and
her heirs for ever. I then give to Mary the
Daughter of Philip Woodhouse one Negro
Woman named Sarah to her & her heirs for
ever. I then give to Enoch Jones one Negro
Boy named Frank, the Son of Merriah,
and to his heirs for ever, I then
give to William Woodhouse, Son of
William Woodhouse all that tract of
Land, left to Robert Holmes & Wife, after
their decease to him and his heirs forever.
I then give to Edward Holmes one black
Man named Genrey to him and his
heirs for ever. All the Remainder of my
estate, after paying my just Debts, of what
kind or quality soever Real or Personal
I give and bequeath to my Foster Daughter
Ann's Notice to her and her heirs forever,
I appoint her Executor and appoint Thomas
Halter her Executor to this my last Will
and Testament Dated this 19th October 1782

one third part of my said Land to my
son John Elks during her Life, I Give my
son John Elks two thirds of my Land where
he comes to Lawful Age and after my Wife's de.
the whole Plantation and Land to him and
his heirs forever. I Give & Bequeath
to my Wife Rebecca Elks all my personal
Estate for the use of the same to maintain and
raise my children upon, I do Nominate
Constitute and Appoint my beloved Wife
Rebecca Elks to be my whole and sole Executor
