weak but of sound mind & disposing memory thankes be to God for it & calling to min
the uncertainty of humane life & ther it is appointed for all men to do his God
what Constituted or deince & appoint this my last will & Testament in manner & form following
that is to day first & principally I commit my soul into the hands of almighty God my
Savior hoping to obtain mercy & forgiuenesse of all my sins & a joyful resurrection
to Eternall life through the righteousnes & merits of Jesus Christ my redemer and
my body to the earth to be buried after the discretion of my Execr hereafter named &
as for those worldly goodes it hath pleased God to endow me with I give & beguath as fol-
loweth, — I give & beguath unto my son John Leamont one hundred and nine
man called Singe it being in full of all that portion that was given to him by his
father & grand father in any wayes from me due to him to him his heirs for ever, —
Item I give & beguath unto my son John Leamont three hundred & sixt
his heirs for ever, — It I give & beguath unto my son Thomas Leamont all my
stock of hoggs it being in full of all that mody which was given to him by his father
& grandfather, — It I give & beguath unto my daughter Susanah Jones on bay mare
with a bold face to her other heirs for ever, — It I give & beguath unto my son John
Leamont one young black mare to him & his heirs for ever, — It I give to my son
Henry Leamont one sorrel mare with a bare face to him & his heirs for ever, —
At & yeare & day next unto my son John Leamont all the remainder of my heire

and mārs not already giuen to him & his heirs for ever; — It. I giue & beq[uo]tch unto my
daughter Sarah Jones my Chest with all my woeing Cloathes & two
Stone ring on Silver boddings one pair of Silver buckles & one side scabbard to her and her
heirs for ever; — It. I giue & beq[uo]tch unto my sons Edward John & Henry Lamour
all my Stock of Hoope to be Equally Dividēd between them to them & their heirs for ever;
Item I giue to my son Edward Lamour one feather bed to him & his heirs for ever;
It. I giue & beq[uo]tch unto my daughter Sarah Jones one feather bed & furniture now
was formerly giuen her by her father will; — It. I giue & beq[uo]tch unto my sons John &
Thomas Lamour one linin wholle apice to them & their heirs for ever; item I giue
beq[uo]tch unto my four sons to wit Edward John Thomas & Henry Lamour all my powter
to be Equally Dividēd between them to them & their heirs for ever; — It. I giue & beq[uo]tch
unto my son Edward Lamour one great blackwalnut Table & pair of Holland Shears to him
& his heirs for ever; — It. I giue unto my Son John Lamour one piee Table to him & his
heirs for ever; — It. I giue to my three sons to wit Edward John & Thomas Lamour one
Spit a piece I likewise give to my son John Lamour one great church bibly; — It. I giue
6000 wath to my son John & Henry Lamour all my Cropp & Share now growing upon the
ground that ready gather this year that is today wheat Corn Tobacco flax pease & barley
Cocher to be Equally Dividēd between them to them & their heirs for ever; — It. I giue an
beq[uo]tch all y^e remainder of my Stock of Cattle not already giuen to my two Sons to wit
Edward & John Lamour to be Equally Dividēd between them to them & their heirs for ever
And further my will & Desir is that my son John Lamour take Care of my Daughter Sarah
Jones & what she hath in her minority & further it is my will & Desir that my son Henry
Lamour boar ful & free liberty or agd to act & do for himself from this time forward
and last of all I do by these presents ordain & appoint my two Sons Edward & John Lamour
to be my ful & sole Exors of this my last will & Testament as witness my hand & seal this
y^e 24th day of August 1726

Signed sealed & Sealed & dated the first day of August 1726 S. Jones & John
Lamour in presence of us — Then & within last will of Sarah Jones Doe was
John Corrick bound in Court by her Exors whom I do oath thereto
Sarah (e) Bollis being proved by 4th oaths of all y^e witness thereto is admitted to record
