merciful pains as God in his great mercy hath pleased to ordain me with I give and bequeath that followeth
Item I give to my son Thomas one feather bed & bolster & one blanket & one coverlet & one
pillow & spit & two powder plates and I give to my son Samuel one feather bed & bolster & blanket & one
pillow & one powder plate and I give to my son Samuel one feather bed & bolster & blanket & my gun and
my horse that is called mine & one powder basin & two powder plates and I give to my daughter Mary
one looking glass one brass pan & brass warming pan and I give to my son John one shilling
sterling & to my daughter Mary Brooks one shilling sterling in full of their parts of my Estate and I give to
my grandson Henry Fitzgerald one powder dish and I give to my granddaughter Hester Fitzgerald one
silver dram cup and I give to my loving wife Elizabeth my book of prayer & furniture & all the
rest of my personal Estate & 1/2 of my plantation during her natural life: and my son Thomas to
have half of my orchard provided he keep it well fenced and I give all my land to my son Thomas and the
male issue of his body & in default of such issue to my son Samuel & his issue in default of such
son & issue and his issue & I do appoint & ordain my aforesaid wife Elizabeth to be my whole and sole
Excutrix of this my last will & Testament; In witness I have set my hand & seal this 26. Day of July
1714
