frailties of this mortal life knowing that it is appointed unto all to die & to make
an account of their lives I do make out in manner & form following the first & particularly
I give & bequeath my soul to God that giveth it in trusting thought of his merits & of my
blessed Saviour to have Richen of falling sins & my body to be decently buried at
the discretion of my wife hereafter named & for such my wife to a God in his mercy hath be-
stowed on me I give & bequeath as followeth: I give I give & bequeath to my loving wife
Elizabeth Corprow my white horse called Curago to her & her heirs for ever. I give & bequeath
unto my son Tho: Corprow my plantation where I now live with all the appurtenances thereon
belonging that is to say a lot of land belonging to it with a piece of that land belonging to that land
that I did buy of Mr. Eiland which Division line shall begin at a branch where my wife gets -
said road to run by a line of marked trees at top of ridge unto him & his heirs for ever but my
will & desire is that my wife shall have & use of & for said plantation during her life
I give unto my son Tho: Corprow a negro girl called Doray & her increase unto him & his heirs for ever
I give & bequeath unto my daughter Abiah Church 1/2 of a certain part of that tract of land & plantation
that I bought of Mr. Eiland unto her & to & of the use of her body lawfully begotten for ever. I give &
bequeath unto my daughter Apphia one plantation & tract of land called & known by the name of
Bushes & one negro girl called Judy with her increase unto her & her heirs for ever. I give & bequeath
unto my daughter Abiah Church two Cows & Calves in full of her portion with sundry other things
which she is already possessed with from me. I: my will & desire is that all & every one of my Estate
be equally divided betwixt my loving wife Eliz: Corprow & my son Tho: & my daughter Apphia my
Just debts being first satisfied also my will & desire is that if plantation & if Cattle which doth
belong to me in Coratuck be rented by Cattle to pay Dickson Children their portion Lastly
I now do constitute & appoint my loving wife my whole sole Ex: of my last will & Testament
utterly voiding & annulling all other wills by me formerly made Ratifying & Confirming this
to be my last will & Testament & to be true & lawful I have hereunto set my hand & fixed my Seal
this 11th day of March in the 4th year of our Lord God 1721

 unto my daughter Abiah Church two Cow & Calves in full of her portion with sundry other things
 which she is already possessed with from me. - It: my will & desire is that all y^e rest of my Estate
 be equally divided betwix my loving wife Eliza: Corprow & my son Tho: & my daughter Apphia my
 Just debts being first satisfied also my will & desire is that y^e plantation & y^e Cattle which doth
 belong to me in Coratuck be sold by Cattle Sould to pay Dickson's Children their portion lastly
 I nominate to constitute & appoint my loving wife my whole & sole Ex^{or} of my last will & Testament
 utterly revoking & disanulling all other wills by me formerly made Ratifying & Confirming this
 to be my last will & Testament & to y^e truth hereof I have hereunto set my hand & fixed my seal
 this 11th day of March in y^e 4th year of our Lord God 1721
