his heirs forever. I Give & Bequeath
to my Wife Rebecca Elks all my personal
Estate for the use of the same to maintain and
raise my Children upon, I do Nominate
Constitute and Appoint my beloved Wife
Rebecca Elks to be my whole and sole Executor
