 clanhan my do. wife three pots & one little. It. I give unto y^e. about said In machlanhan
 one my lowering wife Elousoyouth. Dishes two barons two pottages six plates one dent. and one
 one Chamber pot. It. I give unto y^e. about said In machlanhan my do. wife one leather Couch
 and also I do appoint my deary beloved wife Joan Atkinton & my son in law In machlanhan
 to be my whole & sole Exors. this my last will & Testament I have herunto set my hand &
