In the Name of God Am on the seventh day of October in the year of our
hundred & twenty one I Thomas Lewis of Surhaw parish in county of ... do now have and leave
Sick & weak in body but of perfect mind & memory thank God for I am willing to make
mortality of my body & knowing that it is expected of me to die do make & ordain this
my last will & Testament to say principally first of all give to my soul my undying hope
of God that governs my body I command to go to be buried in Christ Jesus in the grave
in hope of a joyful resurrection of same & though residing out of town I do give to my
son for my worldly Estate wherewith it shall please God to bless you with in this world
disposse of the following manner & form:.... I do give to my son John Lewis
my part of my plantation wherout now living & have it by him to be sold
to pay to him effects of his life & to the poor in his parish
acknowledged that I have a debt of £1000 in Old Bank of Boston
Expend my son John Lewis to pay the sum of £1000
heretofore owing him if he be so farre debited him
I will pay to John Lewis the sum of £1000 in old bank of Boston
and direct unto him that he may have the same & to have the same delivered being
so fully paid up & discharged & satisfyed before — I do give to my son
John Lewis my son John Lewis which he doth with — I do give to my son
John Lewis the sum of £1000 of old money my son John Lewis to be equally divided among my
children & on this same day in this year.

I begueth unto my beloved wife my Negro follow Tom & negro named Casoy during her natural life after her decease I begueth unto my son James Ewold Negro follow Tom & to my daughter Mary Lewis & Negro worth Casoy — I begueth unto my daughter Mary Ewold my negro named Casoy to be delivered to her when she cometh to age of eighteen years for which time he is to serve him & his children her — I begueth unto my fourth child that they shall bring between them & his children of my two wives Casoy half & half between them & his children — my daughter Mary Lewis received those — I begueth unto my wife all my hogs except one black sow to Capt. Calvert and all my Sheep — I begueth unto my son Solomon Ewold two hogs of twenty dares each & all their increase from this time till he comes to age of twenty one years & then to be delivered to him they shall their increase & meat of the two hogs before delivered to him into hands of her master for him to him his hogs for ever — I begueth unto my loving wife her hogs of forty of each to take & to have which she thinks fit if in case my beloved wife deceased before me time mentioned for my four children to receive where I have given unto them in order that my said children James, Mary, Thos. Solomon & Ewold to receive & be put in possession of all that give them their hogs for ever — I order & appoint four trustees of four years each to be disposed of so that I ad vantag & economy to be equally divided between me — ~~me~~: max: Bowring: Coriolis Calvert towards paying them what I am indebted to them & all & cost of my Cattell I order to be inventoryed & equally to be divided amongst my wife & four children James, Mary, Thos. Solomon & Ewold whom they come to age that's appointed to receive first of their Estates before mentioned. All & cost to divide the remainder of my Estates not already disposed of I order & command to be appraised: and I do appoint Gorden & Lot: Thos. Walker my loving brother in law William Gilburn to be Ex'ts of this my last will & Testament if in case either of them deceaseth I appoint m^r Charles Dyer in his stead hereby revoking all & every former will by me at any time hereto formed & in witness whereof I have herowise set my hand & seal & day this year first within written — Prince George County held the 6th Decemb: 1721 Thos. Ewold attested —
