

I bequeath unto my beloved wife my Negro fellow Tom Negro wench Carry during her natural
 life after her decease I bequeath unto my son James Ewell & Negro fellow Tom to my daughter
 Mary Ewell & Negro wench Carry — I bequeath unto my daughter Mary Ewell my Negro wench
 alias to be delivered to her when she comes to y^e age of eighteen years & when she comes to y^e
 of time she receives her: — I bequeath unto my four children equally to be divided among
 them all & increase of my two wench Carry & alias that they shall bring between this & y^e time
 my daughter Mary Ewell receives them — I bequeath unto my wife all my Negro excepting
 son James & cow to Cap: Calvert and all my Sheep: — I bequeath unto my son Solomon Ewell
 two hives of the very year old each & all their increase from this time till he comes to y^e age of
 twenty one years when to be delivered to him they & all their increase & man of the two hives
 to be altered & put into some other mark for him to him & his heirs for ever: — I bequeath unto my
 loving wife her heirs of all my feather beds to take one which she thinks fit in case my
 beloved wife decease before y^e time mentioned for my four children to receive what I have given
 on them then in order that my said children James Mary Tho: Solomon Ewell receive & be put in
 possession of all that is given them they & their heirs for ever — I order & appoint four stores
 of four y^e aged each to be disposed of to y^e best advantage of money to be equally divided between
 my: Mary: Bouché Cap: Cornelius Calvert to ward paying them what I am indebted to them & all
 y^e rest of my Cattle I order to be inventoryed & equally to be divided amongst my wife & four children
 James Mary Tho: Solomon Ewell when they come to y^e age that is appointed to receive y^e rest of their
 Estate before mentioned. Y^e rest I reserve & remainder of my Estate not already disposed of I
 order & ordain to be appraised: and I do appoint & ordain let: Tho: Walker my loving brother in
 law William Lilburn to be Exors of this my last will & Testament & if in case either of them decease
 then I appoint m^r: Charles Loyer in his stead hereby revoking all & every former wills by me at
 any time hereto forwaded In witness whereof I have hereto set my hand & seal y^e Day
 and year first within written.
