

In the Name of God Amen Tho last will & Testament of Thomas Franklin of Prince of Ann County in Virginia
being sickly & weak in body but in perfect & sound mind & memory knowing the certainty of death but
within the uncertainty of the hour have ordained this last will & Testament as followeth I first give & bequeath
my soul unto almighty God who gaveth to me at first introp of a joyful resurrection of my body at my
last Day through the merits of Jesus Christ my redeemer & my body to the earth to be decently buryed at
the discretion of my Executrix hereafter named — first I do revoke all wills & Testaments made
before by me as for my real Estate I give & bequeath as followeth — Item: I give & bequeath unto my
son William Franklin & plantation wherison I now live being one hundred acres to him & his heirs
for ever also I give & bequeath to William my son two hundred acres in full of his portion — Item: I give
& bequeath unto Tho. Franklin my son of plantation & hef the land belonging to it called by the
name of Bences field to him & his heirs for ever but not to milist his mother of house or clearedd
ground as long as shall be any more there left in any said Land as commonly as a share without damn
ifying each other — Item: I give & bequeath to my son Daniel Franklin the rest of land called by the
name of Bences to him & his heirs forever — Item: I give & bequeath unto my two sons Richard &
Nathaniel Franklin a parcel of land lying & being between Edward Bonney & Tho. Albritton Lan
to be equally divided betwix them to them & their heirs for ever — Item: I give & bequeath unto Tho.
Franklin my son a parcel of land called warr point to him & his heirs for ever — Item: I give & bequeath unto
unto Edward Franklin my son that land I bought of John macke called by the name of George
Cabbon being one hundred acres to him & his heirs for ever — Item: I leave a small piece of land which
I bought of John Richardson to be sold to help to pay my debts as forrest of my estate after my debts
is paid I give to my well beloved wife Sarah Franklin her children but nothing to be forced from her
during her widowhood but if she marry then to be equally divided amongst all appointing my wife
& son Thomas Franklin jointly together to be whole & sole Executrixes of this my last will & Testament
and for validity whereof I have affixed my hand & seal this 17th day of September 1719:
