

In the Name of God Amen I Thomas
 Haynes of Prince George County in the
 Commonwealth of Virginia, being of Sound
 and Disposing Mind and Memory Blessed
 be God do make and Publish this and for
 my last Will and Testament in manner and
 Form following Viz. I Premises Give
 and Bequeath to my beloved Wife Elizabeth
 Haynes my Negro Man Slave named Dick
 my Negro Wench named Kate with all the
 Increase, all my House hold and
 Kitchen Furniture, my Ox Cart and all
 other Plantation Utensils and Implements
 of Husbandry, one bay Mare called Polly
 and Grey Mare called Lucy one bay Horse
 called Hornulus and one Old black Horse
 called Toby my Siding Chair & Churn
 all my Stock of Sheep and Hogs all my
 and Corn that I have laid in for my next
 years provision and all my other things
 except a young Cow the prime of my Stock
 which I give to my Son William Nisbitt Haynes
 to my said Wife Elizabeth and her heirs forever
 Also Give to my Wife Elizabeth Haynes the
 Use of my Tract and Plantation of Land
 containing one Hundred and Sixteen
 or thereabouts more or less, as also the use of
 my two Negroes Sue and Cuffe during her
 natural Life, She in consideration thereof
 to keep Educate and Maintain my Son
 William Nisbitt Haynes until he attains
 the age of sixteen years. Then I Give to my
 Son William Nisbitt Haynes after my
 Wife's decease, the Use of my Tract of Plantation
 of Land before mentioned as also the Use
 of all the Negro Slaves which of Right belong
 or shall belong to me of my said Estate then

the young Cow above Excepted with her increase
 until he arrives at the age of Twenty One years
 or is Married, which shall first happen
 and then to him and his heirs forever, but in case my said Son should Die before
 he arrives at the age of Twenty One years or
 is Married, then I Give and Bequeath the said
 Land and Slaves last mentioned to my
 sister Frances Haynes and to her heirs
 forever. Then I Give and Bequeath the Use of
 my Negroes Sue and Cuffe after my Wife's decease
 and the Use of all the other of my Estate of
 what nature or kind so ever no therein
 before particularly mentioned and otherwise
 devised unto my said Son William
 Nisbitt Haynes until he shall attain the age of
 Twenty one years, or is Married, which shall
 first happen, then I Give the said two Slaves
 and other the residue of my Estate last before
 mentioned to him and his heirs forever. But in case
 my said Son should Die before he attains the
 age of said on Marriage then I Give the
 said two Slaves Sue & Cuffe and the residue
 of my Estate to my said beloved Wife and her
 heirs forever, And lastly I nominate, constitute
 and appoint my beloved friends Wm
 Nisbitt and James Nimmo Executors of my
 last Will and Testament in the which when
 I have executed set my hand and seal
 the Twenty sixth day of December Anno
 Domini One thousand seven hundred & 3
 and the said Thomas Haynes & Seal
 Witnessed and Published
 in presence of
 Thomas Nisbitt, Nisbitt,
 Elizabeth Hunter
 Extra Court held for Prince Anne County the 13th day
 of February 1703
 The above last Will and Testament of Capt.
 Thomas Haynes deceased proved according to
