Princess Anne County Virginia Wills, 1724-1735
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In the Name of God Amen I Thomas Scott being very unwell
and considering the uncertainty of this life & the Eternity
of the hereafter I have made this my last will & Testament
in this manner to wit as followeth: I give I give I give
and hoping trusting through Jesus Christ for mercy
unto my grandson Lason Son of my Son Thomas Scott
that child that comes from the body of my negro girl Ann
that I be kept with its mother until it be able to
manage her Elizabeth that grows or choise of two years old
at my death, & if in case she dies before she comes
my granddaughter Ann, daughter of Anthony Mosley & Frances
Elizabeth two pointer basons of a gallon & a half
my granddaughter Ann Simons a full wood Iron pot & four
pots & four gallons of paper & a half
I give unto my daughter Ann Mosley & my daughter Frances
said negro girl Ann, with all her dress except the child above given to my grandson
Scott & to her my said daughter Frances choise by Thomas & Anthony Mosley
husband for ever, with all the remaining part of my estate to what he loves & to make
appoint him my Executor In witness to all hereon bears witness I have
my hand & seal this 11th day of April an. 1729. (all of a bus Interlining a row of 10 lines)
The words that I use in my 11th line) & (one half of my year old if I have in the 14th line)
of down also appoint him my Executor in my 16th line) was all interlined before I signed
