In the Name of God Amosd Owen Jones being very sick & weak but in perfect
senses & memory & desirous to dispose of his worldly estate as followeth: In I doe
give & bequeath unto my son Robert Jones one shilin Starlin to be paid by my Exor
Owen Jones immediately after y^e said Robert Jones comes of age. - Item I give and
bequeath unto my son Owen Jones & lands warren I live withall of my finances
therunto belonging as also I give unto my son Owen Jones my negroman mingo
withall my worldly goods of the mainer part of my Estate unto my son Owen Jones
whom I appoint Exor to this my last will & Testament wherunto I have set my hand and
Seal this 12. day of October 1734
